6. Description of the contract

Road renovation and bicycle route construction

Nagykanizsa wants to establish a cycling route which will be created in four separate stages with different manner defined in point 7 below.

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers] which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below). All works, supplies and services under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. The participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions**.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers are bind to submit a tender for each lot. Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

Tenderers must provide a tender guarantee of 8 000 EUR when submitting their tender. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful tenderers once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful tenderer(s) upon signature of the contract by all parties.

12. Performance guarantee

No information meeting is planned.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders.

15. Period of implementation of tasks

16. Selection criteria for each Lot

Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

- The average total net annual turnover of the tenderer must exceed 200 000 EUR in all of the last three closed financial years. (please indicate the exchange rate used for calculation)
- The balance sheet earnings of the tenderer can not be negative in the past three closed financial years

Technical and professional capacity of candidate:

- The tenderer must have completed at least three projects of the same nature/complexity as the works concerned by the tender (i.e. road, route, street, path, etc. renovation or construction) and implemented during the last 5 years from the submission deadline together with the worth of 300 000 EUR.
